


why do you need a mammogram?



this is a special x-ray machine that checks your breasts to see if they are healthy





some women may have cancer which is an illness that some women have inside their breasts, it can spread to other parts of the body without treatment



not all women have cancer




getting your breasts screened



you have been asked to go for breast screening



this means the radiographer will check your breasts to see if you have any abnormalities



if you have your breasts scanned and the doctor finds an abnormality he or she will find the right treatment for you
